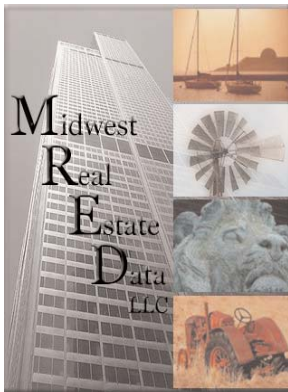

MLSNI & MAP MLS CONSOLIDATE - effective Friday, April 4th, 2008

On Friday April 4th 2008, MLSNI and MAP MLS, through consolidation officially formed Midwest Real Estate Data LLC (MRED). The new organization will provide real estate data service to the areas formerly serviced by both entities.



MRED will be operating from the current MLSNI location in Lisle. The existing customer support numbers, which include tech support, rules & regulations and photo questions, will remain the same. Training classes will continue to be held at all the locations currently hosting training classes.

The goal is to make the transition as seamless as possible to the Brokers and Agents in the marketplace. MRED will continue to provide access to the listing inventory via the MLS Systems currently being used by both organizations and will reassess all of the current technology offerings in the near future.

There will be a few changes you will notice almost immediately. On Monday morning the www.MLSNI.com website will be changed to www.MREDLLC.com. If you have MLSNI.com or MLSNI.net bookmarked, don't worry it will be redirected to the new site. However,

we do recommend that you change your bookmarks, as the redirect will not last forever.

The first time you log into connectMLS you will see a screen asking all licensed Realtors, to Agree or Disagree with the MRED CLICKWRAP AGREEMENT regarding Copyright Policy/Terms of Uses. Once you accept or reject you will not see that screen again.

MRED has decided to adopt MLSNI's Rules and Regulations with some minor changes. The most significant one involves the ordering of photos. In this case MRED has adopted the MAP MLS photo policy. That policy basically states that if you check Service provides photo (Take photo) during listing input, the Service will send a photographer to take the photo within 5 days and you will be billed by your association starting May 1st, 2008, for the cost of the photo. Ordering additional photos will be billed to office/agent just as it was with MLSNI. If during listing input you check Agent will provide the photo, you will need to have the photo uploaded into the system within 48 hours of the listing being added into the system. If your photo does not appear in the system within 10 days, MRED will order the photo to be shot and the agent will be billed through their association.

MRED's interim board has adopted the following changes to removing Market Time from connectMLS, Compass and ReXplorer Agent

Reports. These changes take effect, Monday April 7th, 2008.

- Remove the 1-line with Market Time Report
- Remove Market Time from ALL Detail Reports – Listing Market Time will still display

These changes will not effect the display of Market Time displaying on Listing/ Property History, CMA Reports, and Custom Format fields list. The Market Time will still be used to calculate Average Market Time on any statistical reports.

Please Note: Average Market Time statistics and Market Time values in CMA reports between Tempo and connectMLS will be inconsistent.
